

SOUTHERN COTSWOLDS
ROTARY YOUNG MUSICIAN OF THE YEAR
Competition Rules - 2007/2008

1. This is a Competition for young musicians aged 18 or under (born after 1st September 1989) who have attained Associated Board Grade 6 standard or above in their chosen instrument.
2. Entrants must either live or attend school in the District areas of Stroud or Cotswold, together with the towns of Malmesbury and Thornbury, between September 2007 and April 2008.
3. Entries will only be accepted when endorsed by the applicant's instrument teacher.
4. The competition is open to all solo instrumentalists. Any previous overall winner of the competition will be ineligible to enter in subsequent years.
5. All contestants may perform with an accompanist or solo. Please refer to competition organiser if it is intended to use any form of recorded music for accompaniment.
6. The Contestant's piece of music should be between 5 and 8 minutes in length in the Preliminary rounds and between 12 and 15 minutes in the Finals.
7. Preliminary heats will be held at local venues during Sundays in January 2008. A Grand Final will be held at Sibly Hall, Wycliffe College on Sunday 24th February 2008.
8. The adjudicators will take into account technical ability, musicality, choice of programme, platform manner and presentation.
9. There will be prizes for the different sections of Strings, Woodwind, Brass, Piano and Percussion. All contestants will receive a Certificate of Participation and the Finals include at least the winners of the different sections.
10. Those wishing to enter should complete the enclosed application form.
Closing date for entries is 31st October 2006.
